

What is the Partick and Thornwood Ideas Fund?



Partick and Thornwood Ideas Fund is a Participatory Budgeting (PB) initiative funded by the Scottish Government Investing in Communities fund. PB is a democratic way for local people to have a direct say on how public money is spent in their community.

A steering group led by Annexe Communities was formed in 2020 consisting of representatives of community councils, local churches, residents and Partick Housing Association. The group decides on the format and process of each round of funds – ensuring applications are accessible to all who are eligible

Two rounds of voting have already taken place in Autumn 2020 and Spring 2021 funding a variety of projects from knitting supplies for a knit and natter group to Christmas parcels for local children in need. Keep an eye on our social media for further news on how to get involved this autumn!
